**SUMMER CAMP:** Send your child to "Camp Edna" (at Edna Libby) or "Camp Jack" (at G.E. Jack) this summer and give them a summer experience to remember! Campers will have the opportunity to be involved in a variety of activities including arts and crafts, dance, physical fitness, sport skills, swimming, outdoor education and games. We offer a variety of enrollment options so that working and non-working parents can design a schedule that works best for them.

## CAMP INFORMATION

**TIMES:** Monday-Friday, 9:00 a.m. - 3:00 p.m.

**LOCATIONS:** "Camp Jack" (Ages 10-15)  
"Camp Edna" (Ages 6 -9)

**FEES:** \$350.00 (1st child), \$300.00 (2nd child), \$275.00 (each additional child). The reduced rate for multiple child families applies to siblings only.

(Eligibility for all programs is determined by the child's age as of Oct. 15, 2009.)

### Enrollment Options to Consider:

\* Extended Day Program - Campers can arrive as early as 7:30 a.m. and can remain at camp until 5:30 p.m., with supervised, non-structured activities. Fees listed below are per child for the entire summer.

A.M. Only	(7:30 - 9:00)	\$95.00
P.M. Only	(3:00 - 5:30)	\$150.00
Both A.M. & P.M.		\$225.00

\* Weekly Rate - Looking for a change from the typical summer routine? Consider signing your child/children up for one-week time slots. The weekly rate for a regular day is \$75.00; extended day is \$100.00. Child pays the camper rate for the field trip that week.

\* Daily Rate Option - Participants will be permitted to register for any day/s of the week but will be restricted to attending only on the days they signed up for. **There is no pay-as-you-go option for the daily rate.**

### Friday Field Trips

These trips are optional for campers as camp will remain open on these days. Payment in full will reserve a space, which is limited. Refunds will not be given for missed trips. Non-campers wishing to participate in field trips can only do so by purchasing the entire field trip package. Once camp begins, field trip payments must be made in the Clerk's Office at Town Hall.

## SPECIALTY CAMPS

**Pee-Wee Camp**-This program is designed to promote a positive developmental learning experience through exposure to a fun environment. Activities will include arts & crafts, music & movement and field trips.

**AGES:** 4-6 (6 year-olds have the option of choosing pee-wee or regular camp)

**TIMES:** Monday-Thursday,  
9:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m.

**LOCATION:** Edna Libby

**FEES:** \$150.00 for 1st child, \$125.00 for each additional child. Weekly rate - \$30.00

**Adventure Camp** - This program is offered to both full and part-time campers ages 12-15 to promote self-esteem, confidence, leadership skills & teamwork through involvement in adventure programming. Members of the group will make decisions as to what activities they will participate in, and should be committed to assisting in fundraising efforts to support these activities. There is also a community service component to this program. No additional costs to the parent for participation in this program. Each camper will sign a contract, and if this contract is not kept then the camper will no longer be allowed to participate.

**Explorers Camp** - This camp is designed to prepare the 10 - 11 year old campers for their eventual involvement in the Adventure Camp Program. Activities will promote team-building and leadership skills, with an emphasis placed on exploring the leisure opportunities available to them. There is no additional fee to participate, however, the "explorers" will be required to participate in fund raising events to support their activities.

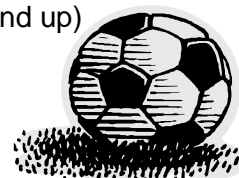

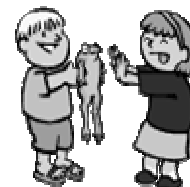

We're getting back to nature & remembering what summer camp is all about! This program will have a little bit of everything for our nature enthusiasts - hiking, orienteering, "survival skills", and more.



**AGES:** 6-9

**TIMES:** 9:30 a.m. — 11 a.m.

**DATES:** Thursdays, 6 weeks beginning 7/2

**FEES:** \$30.00—camper; \$50—non-camper

**Registration Information:** Please fill out a form for every child in the family that is participating, and be sure to take the discount for each additional child in the family. You will need to come into the Town Hall during the following registration times only in order to register your child. **Registrations will not be accepted in the clerk's office or by mail.** Registration dates, times and locations are as follows:

Wednesday, May 13 - Recreation Dept. 5:00—8:00 p.m.

Thursday, May 14 -Council Chambers 7:30—9:00 a.m.

Monday, May 18 - Recreation Dept. 5:00—8:00 p.m.

Wednesday, May 20 \* - Council Chambers 7:30—9:00 a.m. & 3:30—5:30 p.m.

For anyone wishing to register after this date, there will be a \$25.00/person late charge for campers and a \$5.00/child late fee for Outreach participants. Since space is limited in our programs, there is no guarantee that late registrants will be accepted. Some programs require a minimum enrollment, and may be canceled if that minimum is not met.

**Payment Information:** A payment plan is available, with a non-refundable deposit of \$50 being required at time of registration. Outreach activities are required to be paid for at registration to secure a space. All balances are due by **Friday, June 12**. Any child with a balance due on their account when camp begins will not be permitted to participate in any of the Outreach Activities or Field Trips until the balance is paid. (Field Trips are the only activities that aren't required to be pre-paid, as we will accept payments for those in the **Clerk's Office at Town Hall** by Wednesday of that week—these payments will not be accepted at camp this summer.) Camp payments can be mailed or they can be brought into the Clerk's Office during regular business hours if you wish to receive a receipt. You do not need to pay final balances in the Recreation Dept. office. If you have questions regarding your balance, please call the Recreation Department at 642-2875.

**Scholarship/Subsidy Information:** Anyone who receives assistance with camp fees through some type of subsidizing agency will need to provide written verification of this with the registration form. For any child who qualifies and is not currently connected with a subsidizing agency (i.e. DHS), there are limited scholarship funds available for Standish residents only. If you wish to apply for this, you will need to make an appointment with the General Assistance administrator by calling 642-3461.

**Non-resident Information:** There is an additional registration charge for nonresidents enrolling in camp (\$25/child; maximum charge of \$40/family). There is no nonresident fee for outreach activities.

**T-shirt Information:** Please remember to indicate your child's t-shirt size if needed. T-shirts are needed for all campers and for any non-campers who are signing up for Friday field trips. T-shirts are not provided to children enrolling in Outreach activities only.

**Swim Lessons:** Lessons are offered on Tuesday only this year. When registering, please indicate which level you feel the child is at based on the guidelines below.

**Novice:** *This class is for the child who is afraid or very, very leery of water.*

**Level 2:** *For the child who can doggy paddle; can dive down under; can swim a little bit on their back, and swims without taking their arms out of the water.*

**Level 3:** *For the child who can get their arms out of the water when they swim. They need to learn rhythmic breathing, the front crawl and the back crawl.*

**Level 4:** *For the child who knows the front crawl, back crawl and rhythmic breathing. They are ready to learn other strokes.*
