Re: Working Fire at 5 Bog Alley, Standish

At 03:50 am today's date Standish Fire-EMS received a call from the neighbor of 5 Bog Alley (located on Sebago Lake) in Standish reporting that his neighbor woke them up reporting his house was on fire.

Crews arrived 10 minutes from the time of call to find heavy fire showing from the single family single story year round camp style home.

The home was located in the Harmon's Beach Neighborhood on Sebago Lake. The property owner was the only one home at the time and was awakened by smoke and fire, he was able to get out and go to the neighbors for help.

Water was pulled from a Dry Hydrant from Sebago Lake at Harmon's Beach a few hundred feet away from the residence.

The residence is a total loss the cause is determined to be a chimney fire that extended to the structure.

There were no civilian or Firefighter injuries.

Units cleared the scene at 06:00 am
