Greetings:

In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby required to notify the inhabitants of the Town of Standish, in the County of Cumberland, qualified by law to vote in town affairs, to meet at the Standish Municipal Building in Standish, on SATURDAY, the THIRTEENTH DAY of JUNE, A.D. 2015, at 9:00 in the forenoon, to act on the following Articles, namely:

Art. 1. To choose a moderator to preside at said meeting.

Art. 2. To see if the Town will vote to approve the following estimated General Fund REVENUES for the operation of the Town for the period July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016 as recommended by the Municipal Officers:

Art. 4. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the following estimated General Fund CODE ENFORCEMENT expenditures for the period July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016 as recommended by the Municipal Officers:

Art. 5. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the following estimated General Fund GENERAL ADMINISTRATION expenditures for the period July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016 as recommended by the Municipal Officers:

Art. 17. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the following estimated General Fund SOLID WASTE expenditures for the period July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016 as recommended by the Municipal Officers:

Art. 18. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the following estimated General Fund RECREATION expenditures for the period July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016 as recommended by the Municipal Officers:

Art. 19. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the following estimated General Fund DONATIONS expenditures for the period July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016 as recommended by the Municipal Officers:

Art. 20. To see if the Town will vote to raise from property taxes and appropriate from both property taxes and bond proceeds the following estimated General Fund CAPITAL expenditures for the period July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016 as recommended by the Municipal Officers:

Operations: \$1,461,746

Art. 21. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the following estimated General Fund EMPLOYEE BENEFITS expenditures for the period July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016 as recommended by the Municipal Officers:

Operations: \$689,023

Art. 22. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the following estimated General Fund INSURANCE expenditures for the period July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016 as recommended by the Municipal Officers:

Operations: \$74,239

Art. 23. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the following estimated General Fund DEBT SERVICE expenditures for the period July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016 as recommended by the Municipal Officers:

Operations: \$1,006,892

Art. 24. To see if the Town will vote to appropriate \$400,000 from UNASSIGNED FUND BALANCE ("Surplus") of the Town for the purpose of reducing the property tax commitment in the 2016 fiscal as recommended by the Municipal Officers.

Art. 25. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Town Council to accept and expend, on behalf of the Town, federal, state or private funds received in the form of grants or gifts during the period from July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016.

Art. 26. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Town Council to expend such sums of money as it deems necessary from the impact fee reserve account

for its designated purpose during the period from July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016 as recommended by the municipal officers.

Art. 27. To see if the town will vote to increase the property tax levy limit to \$2,820,718 established for the Town of Standish by State law in the event that the municipal budget approved under the preceding articles will result in a tax commitment that is greater than that property tax levy limit.


[If necessary to be voted on, State law requires that Article 27 be voted on by paper ballot.]

Art. 28. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate \$ 2,755,902 by property taxation towards the 2015/2016 annual budget as recommended by the municipal officers.




