Re: 2nd Alarm Structure Fire 1080 Chadbourne Road (Route 35)
Standish, Maine

Standish Fire-EMS was called to 1080 Chadbourne Road in Standish for a reported Chimney Fire at 2115 on December 20, 2010. On arrival at 2123 we found a 2 1/2 story Cape Style Home with an attached apartment smoke was coming from the eaves. Firefighters located the fire in the attic space above the kitchen. The Fire burned through the roof over the kitchen but was contained to that area of the house. The remainder of the home suffered smoke, heat and water damage.

The Fire was declared under control at 2227, one hour after the call. Units were completely clear at 0100 following extensive overhaul and putting out hot spots.

There were no injuries to the home owners or Fire Personnel.

Initial investigation appears to have started around a wood stove and chimney in the kitchen further investigation by the State Fire Marshal's office will be conducted tomorrow.

A family of 7 was home at the time; the family and a tenant have been displaced and are being relocated with help from Red Cross.
