To Peter Sanborn of the Town of Standish Greeting Whereas Levi Sanborn Collector of Taxes for the year 1812 was to whom the Assessors of said Town for the year 1812 were to collect a list of assessment, dated 1812 amounting to \$1229.90 Cents hath become Debilitated Before he hath the collection of said assessment and whereas upon review of such part thereof as the said Levi received in health it appears that the sum of seven hundred & eighty thirty one cents remains uncollected We therefore the undersaid Town of Standish do by virtue of a law of this Commonwealth in such case made and provided hereby appoint you a collector the said sum of seven hundred & eighty eight of the several persons named in the list herewith commencing each one his respective proportion therein set down according and herein you are to execute all such powers as were by granted to the said Debilitated
