Re: Sebago Lake Water Rescue

Standish Fire-EMS, Raymond Fire-Rescue and the Portland Water District Marine Units responded to a reported cap sized Sail Boat that had two sailors on board in Sebago Lake, between Standish, the Two Mile Limit and Frye Island

While responding we were updated that a Good Samaritan boat had arrived with the cap sized sail boat and had the sailors and their dog aboard.

On arrival with the boats, we were able to confirm that the sail boat was upside down and the two sailors and their dog were uninjured.

Conditions on Sebago Lake this afternoon were windy and very rough. The Boat and its occupants were towed back to Frye Island safely; damage to the sail boat is unknown.
