Standish Fire-EMS was called to 21 Easy Street in Standish for a reported kitchen fire at 1931 on December 22, 2010. On arrival at 1941 we found a 2 story Cape Style Home. Firefighters entered the home and found it full of smoke and located the fire in the kitchen. The Fire was contained to the kitchen. The remainder of the home suffered heavy smoke damage.

The Fire was declared under control at 1955, 24 Minutes after the initial call.

There were no injuries to the home owners or Fire Personnel.

The cause of the fire was from cooking oil on the stove. Fortunately when the homeowners evacuated the home they closed the doors keeping the fire contained to the kitchen.

A family of 2 was home at the time; the family has been displaced temporally and will be staying with local extended family
