Re: 2nd Alarm Structure Fire 377 Oak Hill Road Standish, Maine

Standish Fire-EMS was called to 377 Oak Hill Road at 1726 for a reported barn on Fire. On arrival at 1728 pm we found a 25 x 50 barn fully involved. The barn was located 30 feet from the residence. The fire did not spread to the house. The barn collapsed and was a total loss. The barn fire caused a $\frac{1}{2}$ acre brush fire on the property.

The Fire was declared under control an hour after the initial alarm.

Limited water supply hindered fire fighting efforts. A special request for Tank trucks had to be made.

There were no injuries to the home owners or Fire Personnel.

The cause of the fire is not considered suspicious; the fire marshal's office has been called to assist with the cause investigation given the value of the loss.

Mutual Aid on the scene provided by: Buxton, Limington, Gorham, Windham, and Sebago with many of the same communities providing station coverage.
