

**PUBLIC NOTICE  
TOWN OF STANDISH**

At July 10, 2018 regular meeting of the Standish Town Council the following emergency ordinance was adopted, effective immediately:

TITLE: EMERGENCY AMENDMENTS TO STANDISH TOWN CODE, CHAPTER 263, VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, ARTICLE I, PARKING AND WEIGHT RESTRICTIONS

WHEREAS the individuals using the Saco River in the vicinity of Main Street (Route 11) park on Main Street along the non-posted section towards Pequawket Trail (Route 113), and

WHEREAS Main Street is a narrow residential street and cars parking on the entire length of the street cause a traffic hazard for motorists, pedestrians and residents that live on Main Street, now therefore be it

ORDERED that the Town of Standish hereby ordains the following emergency amendments to the Vehicles and Traffic Ordinance, effective immediately and stand automatically repealed as of the 91<sup>st</sup> day following adoption.

The Vehicles and Traffic Ordinance of the Town of Standish shall be amended as follows (additions are underlined and deletions are ~~struck out~~):

§ 263-1 Prohibited parking.

It shall be unlawful to park any vehicle within the public way at the following locations:

Q. On either side of Main Street (Route 11) from Heath Lane to Veterans Memorial Bridge, and from Heath Lane towards Pequawket Trail (Route 113) on the easterly side of Main Street for 500 feet.
