Greetings:

In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby required to notify the inhabitants of the Town of Standish, in the County of Cumberland, qualified by law to vote in town affairs, to meet at the Standish Municipal Building in Standish, on SATURDAY, the SIXTEENTH of JUNE, A.D. 2018, at 9:00 in the forenoon, to act on the following Articles, namely:

Art. 1. To choose a moderator to preside at said meeting.

Art. 2. To see if the Town will vote to approve the following estimated General Fund REVENUES for the operation of the Town for the period July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019 as recommended by the Municipal Officers (*Budget Committee recommends \$4,156,546*):

Art. 25. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the following estimated General Fund TRANSFERS OUT expenditures for the period July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019 as recommended by the Municipal Officers (*Budget Committee recommends \$2,500*):

Operations: \$2,500

This is to fund the annual public safety fair. Funds are transferred out to the special revenue fund where this event is tracked consistent with prior practice.

Art. 26. To see if the Town will vote to appropriate from bond proceeds the following estimated Capital Projects Fund CAPITAL expenditures for the period July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019 as recommended by the Municipal Officers (*Budget Committee recommends \$1,817,405*):

Operations: \$1,879,605

Art. 34. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate \$3,296,659 by property taxation towards the 2018/2019 annual budget as recommended by the municipal officers.

The Registrar of Voters will hold office hours while the meeting is in session to correct an error or change a name or address on the voting list; to accept the registration of any person eligible to vote; and to accept new enrollments.

A person who is not registered may not vote at the annual town meeting.
