The issuing of bonds by the Town of Standish is one of the ways in which the Town borrows money for certain purposes. 

When money is borrowed by issuing bonds, the Town must repay not only the principal amount of the bonds but also interest on the bonds. The amount of interest to be paid will vary depending upon the rate of interest and the years to maturity at the time of issue. The validity of the bonds and of the voters' ratification of the bonds may not be affected by any errors on the estimates made of the costs involved, including varying interest rates, the estimated cost of interest on the bond amount to be issued and the total cost of principal and interest to be paid at maturity. If the actual amount of the total debt service for the bond issues varies from the estimate, the ratification by the electors is nevertheless conclusive and the validity of the bond issue is not affected by reason of the variance.

Question 1.

To see if the Town will vote to approve a capital expenditure by the Municipal Officers of up to \$430,200 for construction of improvements to fire station 1 and acquisition of public safety vehicles and dry hydrants, such expenditures to be financed from proceeds of the issuance of general obligation bonds or notes, hereby authorized, with the dates, maturities, denominations, interest rate(s) and other details of such borrowing to be determined by the Municipal Officers?

(Note: Total estimated debt service of \$498,150, of which principal is \$430,200 and estimated interest at rates ranging from 2.00% to 3.25%, depending on the year of maturity, over 10 years is \$67,950).

The Municipal Officers recommend a YES vote.

Question 2.

To see if the Town will vote to approve a capital expenditure by the Municipal Officers of up to \$250,000 for acquisition of an assessing server and software, and acquisition of land for Town facilities and open space, such expenditures to be financed from proceeds of the issuance of general obligation bonds or notes, hereby authorized, with the dates, maturities, denominations, interest rate(s) and other details of such borrowing to be determined by the Municipal Officers?

(Note: Total estimated debt service of \$289,487, of which principal is \$250,000 and estimated interest at rates ranging from 2.00% to 3.25%, depending on the year of maturity, over 10 years is \$39,487).

The Municipal Officers recommend a YES vote.

Question 3.

To see if the Town will vote to approve a capital expenditure by the Municipal Officers of up to \$71,600 for improvements to the Standish Memorial Park playground, such expenditures to be financed from proceeds of a grant for \$53,600 and proceeds of the issuance of general obligation bonds or notes in an amount of up to \$18,000, hereby authorized, with the dates, maturities, denominations, interest rate(s) and other details of such borrowing to be determined by the Municipal Officers?

(Note: Total estimated debt service of \$20,844, of which principal is \$18,000 and estimated interest at rates ranging from 2.00% to 3.25%, depending on the year of maturity, over 10 years is \$2,844).

To see if the Town will vote to approve a capital expenditure by the Municipal Officers of up to \$135,000 for acquisition of a public works truck with plow gear, 4 wheel driver loader and paint striper, such expenditures to be financed from proceeds of the issuance of general obligation bonds or notes, hereby authorized, with the dates, maturities, denominations, interest rate(s) and other details of such borrowing to be determined by the Municipal Officers?

(Note: Total estimated debt service of \$156,323, of which principal is \$135,000 and estimated interest at rates ranging from 2.00% to 3.25%, depending on the year of maturity, over 10 years is \$21,323).

To see if the Town will vote to approve a capital expenditure by the Municipal Officers of up to \$992,805 for paving and improvements to Boundary Road, Manchester Road, River Meadows Circle, River Meadows Drive and Warren Road and other road improvements, and improvements to the Whites Bridge Road rock wall, such expenditures to be financed from proceeds of the issuance of general obligation bonds or notes, hereby authorized, with the dates, maturities, denominations, interest rate(s) and other details of such borrowing to be determined by the Municipal Officers?

(Note: Total estimated debt service of \$1,149,617, of which principal is \$992,805 and estimated interest at rates ranging from 2.00% to 3.25%, depending on the year of maturity, over 10 years is \$156,812).
