The Town of Standish would like MaineDOT to evaluate the speed limit on Route 113 in the vicinity of Steep Falls Village towards the Baldwin Town Line. The speed is now posted at 35 mph in the village and it rises to 50 mph in the vicinity of the Medical Clinic and the entrance to the Acres of Wildlife Campground. This 50 mph section within Standish has residential build up and a blind curve due to ledge and the Town has concerns regarding the safety though this area.

This area has seen increased vehicle and pedestrian traffic due to improvements in the Steep Falls Village area. The Town is requesting that MaineDOT review this section of Route 113, to consider if decreasing the speed limit is warranted.
