TITLE: <u>AMENDMENTS TO THE STANDISH TOWN CODE, CHAPTER 245, SOLID WASTE RECYCLING</u> <u>AND MANAGEMENT, ARTICLE I, RECYCLING AND DISPOSAL OF SOLID WASTE</u>

The Town of Standish hereby ordains that Chapter 245, "Solid Waste Recycling and Management," of the "Code of the Town of Standish" be and hereby is amended as follows (additions are <u>underlined</u>; deletions are <del>struck out</del>):

# CHAPTER 245 - SOLID WASTE RECYCLING AND MANAGEMENT

### §245-3 Definitions.

SOLID WASTE HAULER, LOCAL – A person who receives compensation for bringing residential solid waste to the SSWTS for a maximum of 15 dwelling units. All dwelling units served must be in the town of Standish and have a current vehicle permit.

# §245-9 License Application.

- <u>C. An application for a local solid waste hauler license under this article shall obtain the following information:</u>
  - (1) Name, address, and annual vehicular permit number of the applicant; and
  - (2) List of households for which the applicant will be collecting solid waste including each household's current annual vehicular permit number; and
  - (3) An agreement to abide by the terms and conditions of this article.

# § 245-13 Deposit of solid waste.

- A. Solid waste haulers shall deposit solid waste at an approved disposal facility other than the SSWTS.
- B. Persons hauling their own residential solid waste <u>and local solid waste haulers</u> shall deposit it at the Town disposal facility.

# § 245-14 Vehicles used by solid waste haulers.

- <u>A.</u> Trucks or other vehicles used by <u>non-local</u> solid waste haulers shall be of the compactor type, watertight and with an enclosed cargo space.
- <u>B.</u> Collection of dry refuse, rubbish and other solid waste materials is permitted in open trucks that are covered. No trucks or other vehicles shall be permitted to scatter any of the contents on any of the streets, highways or roads of the Town. Trucks used to haul solid waste over the streets of the Town must be maintained in a clean and sanitary condition and shall meet all of the requirements of the Town or appropriate state agency where applicable.
