Attachment to Town of Standish Bid for Grader Repair and Painting

I am providing the following recommendations after inspecting the Town's Grader and reviewing the Bid specifications.

1. All glass is secured into the frames with urethane but should be removed to sandblast and paint frames. An add-on to the bid for the removal of the glass, sandblast and paint the frames and re-install the glass with urethane will be \$400.00. All of the glass is old and special care will be taken during the removal. Any replacement for broken glass will be the responsibility of the Town.
2. Bid add-on for the sandblasting and painting of the front and rear wing posts and the wing with the same paint as specified for the grader will be \$1200.00.
3. Bid add-on to sandblast and paint inside the hydraulic hose tunnel will be \$500.00

The total for the grader body repair and painting as specified and bid is \$8500.00. If the three recommendations totaling \$2100.00 are accepted and all done at the same time as the grader the bid price would be \$10,000.00 a savings of \$600.00.
